

Tools for Preparation

1. **Prayer Chain** - Display a large poster with a twenty- four hour period marked off in fifteen minute intervals. Encourage your people to promise to pray for the meeting for fifteen minutes a day at a specific time each day during the week.
2. **Personal Checklist** - A sample is enclosed. Encourage your people to use this in their daily devotion.
3. **Pre-Service Prayer Time** - One month before the meeting, begin having a special prayer meeting about fifteen minutes before every service with the men. Encourage them to spend this time praying specifically for revival in their own hearts.
4. **Prayer Lists** - Encourage your people to create two personal prayer lists, one with the names of those that they would like to see saved in the meeting and the other with the names of those they want to see get back into fellowship with the Lord. A wonderful time of excitement and Christian growth can be experienced as your people see names crossed off of both lists during the meeting.
5. **Material for Personal Workers** - Be sure that all personal workers are prepared to deal with those who come forward and that they have the proper follow up materials to place in the hands of those making decisions.
6. **Attendance Boosters** - It is impossible to reach the unsaved in the meeting if they do not attend. Although we have suggested special night to encourage your people to bring others; they will be only as excited as you are.
